They enjoy being a Teacher Who Appears (as in, when the student is ready the teacher will appear) and sharing their knowledge with others. Taz Chance (she/her) Victoria "Taz" Chance, HPs. 3*^ has been involved with magick her entire life and has been a priestess for well over thirty years. Taz has multiple initiations from several traditions as learning is her passion. She serves the Conclave of the Craft as High Priestess and as President of the Board of Directors. She is also the High Priestess of Naofa Tintean, the Mother Clan of the Conclave. Taz serves the community by teaching classes, offering workshops, facilitating rituals, providing rites of passage, and as member of the OSS Clergy Committee and Board of Directors. She also serves as a consultant, ritual facilitator, and educator for other local groups. Walking with the Ancestors by Taz Chance [Sunday 1:00 pm] Walking with the Ancestors looks at how the knowledge, lived experience, and skills of those that have come before us, both by blood as well as those that have lived in communal spaces with our own ancestors. We will talk about the effects these have on our mind, body, spirit, and soul as well as how it affects the magickal practices we have today. Join us for what we hope is a lively discussion.
