Gate Hours: Gates open Friday at 3:00 and close at 9:00 PM Friday and Saturday nights. No entry from 9:00 pm unless other arrangements have been made by contacting info@oakspiritsanctuary.org Gate opens at 9:00 am Saturday and Sunday mornings. Event closes at 3:00 PM Sunday.

Camping Spots: The grounds of OSS are open and do not have designated camping sites as one might expect at a state park campground. You may camp anywhere that is not a ritual or community space. Tent, pull-behind campers, and drivable camping vehicles are all allowed. Camping is rustic: there are no electric or water hookups, no flush toilets. Porta-potties are available on site. The shower house is not opened for the season yet. Fire Pits: All fires must be kept enclosed in the already established fire pits around the property. All fire pits are treated with the respect given to ritual spaces and we ask that no trash or cigarette butts are thrown in. Pack-in Pack-out: OSS does not offer trash disposal services. Please plan to remove your own trash and recycling.
